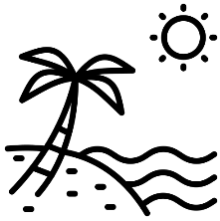
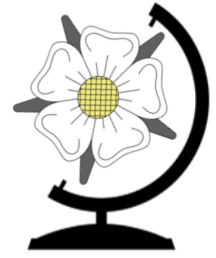


The Bridge to Post-16

This pack contains a programme of activities and resources to prepare you to embark on your Post-16 course in Geography in September.

It should be completed throughout the remainder of the Summer term and over the Summer Holidays to ensure you are ready to start your course in September.

You MUST have this pack completed before your first lesson in the subject

The resources include:

1. Links to three websites where you can research the topics you will be exploring in the course and get a flavour of what you will be learning about in Post-16
2. Research task on key pre-knowledge topics that will help you to be successful in your course.
3. Other relevant revision/questions to help bridge between GCSE and Post-16 courses

Overall we suggest you spend around 3 hours of total work working through the tasks for Geography

Task 1: Multi-hazardous environment Case Study

Link to Specification: Paper 1: Physical Geography: Hazards (worth 40% of Paper 1)

Multi-hazardous environment: *'events involving the simultaneous or sequential occurrence of two or more hazards and their potentially interrelated effects'*. **Basically a place that experiences more than one type of hazard – could be earthquakes and volcanoes, tropical storms, wildfires.**

You need to research a place which is classed as a multi- hazardous environment and **present this**. You can complete the fact file on the next page or present your case study differently.

Suggested Multi hazardous areas: **Haiti, the Phillippines, Japan, California**

Task 2 - Globalisation

Link to Specification: Paper 2: Human Geography: Global Systems and Global Governance (worth 30% Paper 2)

“Globalisation is the increasing connectedness of people and places across the globe”

A key component of increasing globalisation is the growth of trans – national corporations (TNCs). These are large companies that operate in a number of countries. Examples are BP, Apple, Coca – Cola and Toyota, Mattell .

TASK: Research a TNC of your choice. You could choose from the examples above but are welcome to use an alternative. Your research should include;

1. a brief history of the company
2. a map showing which countries it operates in
3. the products that it sells (including how does it globalise for communities)
4. number of employees
5. annual turnover, profits
6. Benefits of the company on the countries they operate in
7. Negatives of the company on the countries they operate in
8. A news article from the last 2 years related to the company
9. How does it contribute to globalisation
