Proposed Reduction of PAN from September 2027

The Local Governing Body of John Taylor Free School are consulting its stakeholders and partners on a proposed change to the admissions arrangements for September 2027.

Reason for the proposal

John Taylor Free School opened in September 2018 with a PAN of 210. This increased to 240 in September 2019. The school has had less than 240 for each Year 7 group for the last 3 years. There have only been 70 – 80 students in Year 7 living within the catchment area which is geographically very small. Even with the new housing being built around Branston Locks, it seems unlikely that the school will be able to fulfil a PAN of 240 year on year.

Current Criteria and Proposed Criteria

There are no plans to change the admissions criteria.

Proposal for Change of PAN

The consultation is proposing a reduction in PAN from 240 students to 210 students giving 7 classes of 30 students.

Process

This proposed change if approved, will become operational from September 2027. 210 students will be admitted to Year 7 from September 2027 onwards. Your opinions are important and we are keen to receive any comments on the proposal before the changes are agreed.

This consultation period opens on Monday 3rd November 2025 and ends on Friday 19th December 2025.

All responses will be considered between Monday 5th January 2026 and Friday 30th January 2026. Admission arrangements will be determined by 28th February 2026.
